## Student exchange

Learning objectives	Language aims: Complete immersion (target language) Improve speaking and listening skills Intercultural aims:
	Create awareness of culture that underlies target language Develop personal social skills
Steps	<ul> <li>Student prepare for exchange by collecting valid information about their destination.</li> <li>Candidates might be encouraged to handle bookings, timetables, phone calls, etc in the process.</li> <li>During the stay, students may write a journal to mark progress and note personal observations concerning culture /language</li> <li>Exchange students may be encouraged to create blog about their experience or communicate with peers over appropriate platforms during their stay abroad</li> <li>To wrap up, candidates may prepare a presentation on their experience to show the rest of the group (in target language).</li> </ul>
Methods	<ul> <li>The exchange student needs close monitoring by at least one teacher.</li> <li>Guidelines on how to go about making the reservations should be given in advance.</li> <li>The form of the journal should be explained beforehand.</li> <li>A teacher needs to supervise the blog and online communication if possible</li> <li>The guidelines to the presentation should be given in advance</li> </ul>

Duration	Exchange: 1 week minimum Preparation: 6 lessons Wrapping up: 1 lesson

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
